Dear Sister, Dear Brother, Dear Reverend Deacon, Dear Reverend Father, From 3rd December churches will be allowed to open again for public celebration of Mass and other acts of worship. The Bishop's Conference of England & Wales have issued a statement welcoming this news. https://www.cbcew.org.uk/bishops-welcome-returnto-public-worship/ For our schools, though there is no change and the previous quidance issued in October stands. Archbishop John has confirmed that it is not yet possible to permit the celebration of Mass in school or by relocating to a church for Mass. Similarly, it is not possible to permit a 'Liturgy of the Word with distribution of Communion'. General guidance for gathering in large groups or mixing of 'bubbles' in school prohibits gathering for Mass or other liturgy that includes the distribution of Communion. The protocols that have been set up for celebration Masses in parishes were designed specifically for the context of the parish community. In the different context of schools, we need to respect the existing adaptations schools have introduced to make those sites safe for pupils and staff. In most cases that includes restricting 'visitors' coming on to school sites and requiring that any 'visitors' do not join existing school based 'bubbles'. In addition, it is important to recognise the health and safety needs of our priests. Archbishop John continues to be heartened to hear of the many ways in which the children and young people who attend the schools and colleges in the diocese are engaging with the wider liturgical life of the Church.
